The Presbytery of Philadelphia held a Called Meeting via Zoom from the Church on the Mall Presbyterian Church in Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 at 10:57 A.M.

While the Presbytery was gathering, the body enjoyed a musical offering entitled "Make Me a River" by Casting Crowns, which spoke to the framing of the conversation at hand.

Moderator, Reverend Ted Mingle (Lower Providence) declared a quorum, calling to order the special meeting of the Presbytery of Philadelphia for the purpose of acting on the recommendation of the Leadership Collegium to endorse the candidacy of the Reverend Ruth Faith Santana-Grace (Presbytery of Philadelphia, Executive Presbyter) to stand for the office of Co-Moderator of the 225th General Assembly.

Moderator Mingle opened the meeting in prayer at 10:57 am. Moderator Mingle then called upon the Stated Clerk, Reverend Kevin Porter (Presbytery of Philadelphia, Stated Clerk) for his report.

From the **Stated Clerk**

Reverend Porter submitted the following:

- Shared the arrangements for voting and how the meeting would be run through the technology.
- Introduced 3 Corresponding Members: Reverends Dr. Edward Santana-Grace (San Gabriel), Shavon Starling-Louis (Charlotte) and Carrie Mitchell (Coastlands). Upon motion and proper second the Presbytery voted to seat them as Corresponding Members.

Moderator Mingle subsequently called for upon any first time Elder Commissioners, who were encouraged to message the office of the Stated Clerk to insure they are appropriately welcomed.

• Elders Janice Thomas (Doylestown) and Evelyn Schwartz (Philadelphia, First) were welcomed

At the conclusion of his report, Moderator Mingle lifted up the one item of business for this Called Meeting:

• To receive and act upon the recommendation of the Presbytery Leadership Collegium to endorse our Executive Presbyter, the Reverend Ruth Faith Santana-Grace to stand as Co-Moderator of the 225th General Assembly.

Prior to the motion being made, the Presbytery heard a presentation about Reverend Santana-Grace's call:

- Moderator Mingle spoke to the background of what being Co-Moderator of the General Assembly entails, and what Reverend Santana-Grace would be tasked with doing.
- Reverend Santana-Grace spoke to her sense of call, and journey to stand as Co-Moderator.
- Reverend Todd Stavrakos (Gladwyne) spoke to the moderatorial history within the Presbytery of Philadelphia
- Reverends Carla Jones Brown (Arch Street) and Dr. John Willingham (Doylestown) spoke on behalf of the Committee on Personnel of the Presbytery
- Reverend Porter, on behalf of the Presbytery Staff, lifted up the support and logistics if Ruth prevails.
- Reverend Dr. Janel Dixon (Cedar Park) spoke to the healing Ruth's spirit has to offer the larger Church.

At the conclusion of the presentation, Reverend Santana-Grace was excused from the room and Moderator Mingle presented the motion. After discussion the Presbytery voted to endorse the Reverend Ruth Faith Santana-Grace to stand as Co-Moderator of the 225th General Assembly.

Moderator Mingle made a motion, **which was duly seconded and approved** to adjourn the meeting with Vice Moderator Zandra Maffett's (Valley Forge) prayer.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Vice-Moderator Maffett at 12:45 P.M.
